



Years 5 and 6

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Monday	<p><u>Maths:</u> <u>TT Rockstars:</u> Try some daily rockstars. Can you challenge other children to battles and can you improve your time and score? <u>My Maths:</u> There are plenty of tasks on MyMaths for you to complete. You can choose what you would like to learn about. <u>Activity:</u> Can you use a recent shopping receipt to find the differences and costs of different items? You could work out the difference between the most and least expensive item, choose your 3 favourite items and add these together, you could then work out the difference between this and the total amount. You could work out how much change you would have if you paid with £ x amount of money or think about how much more money you would need if you only had £ x amount. As a challenge, could you work out what % of the total amount your 3 favourite items account for? Year 6: What is the mean (average) of the total cost?</p>
	<p><u>English:</u> <u>Reading:</u> Try to read some of your book every day. When you finish a book, complete a book review in your green book. <u>SPAG:</u> Use spag.com and choose a task that you would like to complete. <u>Writing:</u> Can you watch or think of your favourite film. This film will be the focus of the writing tasks for the week. Write a paragraph or two of a film review. What happens in the film? Who are the main characters? Which parts are your favourite and why?</p>
	<p><u>Topic:</u> <u>Art:</u> Thinking about Kandinsky and how he painted and created artwork to music, can you choose a piece of music of your own and create a picture whilst listening to it? Remember that Kandinsky always tried to express his emotions linked with the song.</p>
Tuesday	<p><u>Maths:</u> <u>TT Rockstars:</u> Try some daily rockstars. Can you challenge other children to battles and can you improve your time and score? <u>My Maths:</u> There are plenty of tasks on MyMaths for you to complete. You can choose what you would like to learn about. <u>Activity:</u> Think about supermarkets and a previous lesson we had on the cost of different items in different supermarkets. Can you choose 6 items you would add to a shopping list? Then using online shopping, work out which supermarket you would buy from- this may be because it is cheaper, or it may be because they have all of your items in stock. Is there a difference between the costs at different supermarkets?</p>
	<p><u>English:</u> <u>Reading:</u> Try to read some of your book every day. When you finish a book, complete a book review in your green book.</p>

	<p><u>SPAG:</u> Use spag.com and choose a task that you would like to complete.</p> <p><u>Writing:</u> Using the film from yesterday, can you choose a character and describe them. Use evidence from the film to describe what the character looks like and acts like. Think about our use of PE (Point and Evidence) from class to support your description.</p>
<p>Wednesday</p>	<p><u>Topic:</u></p> <p><u>Science:</u> Can you create a puppet show using torchlight? You could create shadow puppets using something opaque (a cardboard cereal box would work). You could film your puppet show or take pictures and email them to me or share them on a PurpleMash blog.</p> <p><u>Maths:</u></p> <p><u>TT Rockstars:</u> Try some daily rockstars. Can you challenge other children to battles and can you improve your time and score?</p> <p><u>My Maths:</u> There are plenty of tasks on MyMaths for you to complete. You can choose what you would like to learn about.</p> <p><u>Activity:</u> Can you complete a time diary for one of your days? Record the times that events happen in both digital (12h and 24h) and analogue times (you could draw mini-sketches of clock faces). This may include the time that you got up, the time you had your breakfast, the time you sat down to do your home learning, the time you did something fun- anything that happens in your day!</p> <p><u>English:</u></p> <p><u>Reading:</u> Try to read some of your book every day. When you finish a book, complete a book review in your green book.</p> <p><u>SPAG:</u> Use spag.com and choose a task that you would like to complete.</p> <p><u>Writing:</u> Choose a setting from the film. Can you describe the setting? Think about describing it to someone who hasn't seen the film and allowing them to picture it in their mind. (You can draw it too if you wish).</p> <p><u>Topic:</u></p> <p><u>Music:</u> Can you take a song/piece of music that you like and look at the lyrics? Think about how we analysed song lyrics in class by looking at the description used and what the writer wants us to think about. Can you do this for a song of your choice?</p>
<p>Thursday</p>	<p><u>Maths:</u></p> <p><u>TT Rockstars:</u> Try some daily rockstars. Can you challenge other children to battles and can you improve your time and score?</p> <p><u>My Maths:</u> There are plenty of tasks on MyMaths for you to complete. You can choose what you would like to learn about.</p> <p><u>Activity:</u> Using your timetable from yesterday, can you write some of your own word problems and work out the answers? Questions may include 'How long did you spend eating your breakfast?', 'How much time had passed between eating your breakfast and having your lunch?' and 'What time would you finish at if you spend 67 minutes reading and start at 13:27?'</p> <p><u>English:</u></p> <p><u>Reading:</u> Try to read some of your book every day. When you finish a book, complete a book review in your green book.</p> <p><u>SPAG:</u> Use spag.com and choose a task that you would like to complete.</p> <p><u>Writing:</u> Can you create a mind map of a plan for your own scene that would work in the film? You could do this on 2connect on Purple Mash if you wish.</p> <p><u>Topic:</u></p>

	<p><u>Science:</u> Using Purple Mash, can you complete the 2do tasks of 'How light travels' and 'Lights and Mirrors'</p>
<p>Friday</p>	<p><u>Maths:</u> <u>TT Rockstars:</u> Try some daily rockstars. Can you challenge other children to battles and can you improve your time and score? <u>My Maths:</u> There are plenty of tasks on MyMaths for you to complete. You can choose what you would like to learn about. <u>Activity:</u> Can you create a timetable of your own perfect day? If you could do anything you wanted and for however long you wanted, what would your day look like? Remember to include the times that you would carry out different events!</p>
	<p><u>English:</u> <u>Reading:</u> Try to read some of your book every day. When you finish a book, complete a book review in your green book. <u>SPAG:</u> Use spag.com and choose a task that you would like to complete. <u>Writing:</u> Write a playscript for your own scene. Remember that a playscript does not need inverted commas. A character name is followed by a colon : and actions/stage directions are in <i>italics</i> or brackets (). You can add new characters to your playscript too!</p>
	<p><u>Topic:</u> <u>Computing:</u> Can you work on Purple Mash to start working on coding? There are two 2do tasks set for you called 'Fun with Fish' and 'Bubbles'</p>
<p>Extra Learning</p>	<p>Can you work on your own project idea that you created in class? Build a den (with parent permission!). You could use a sheet of fabric, cushions and anything else you can think of. Can you read your book by torchlight in it or have a picnic with your family? Do an observational drawing of something that is in your house. It could be a person, a piece of food or an object such as a lantern or piece of furniture. Can you do a zoomed in picture too? If you are struggling with the work on timetables, then use a clock at home and work with a parent of practising o'clock, half past, quarter to and past and then moving onto 5 minute increments.
