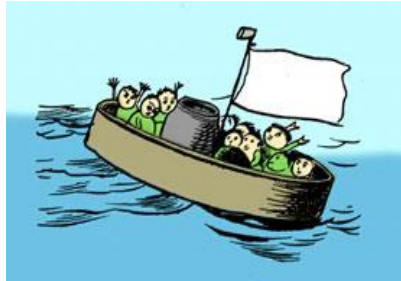

6. What did Aunt Sponge fall on?

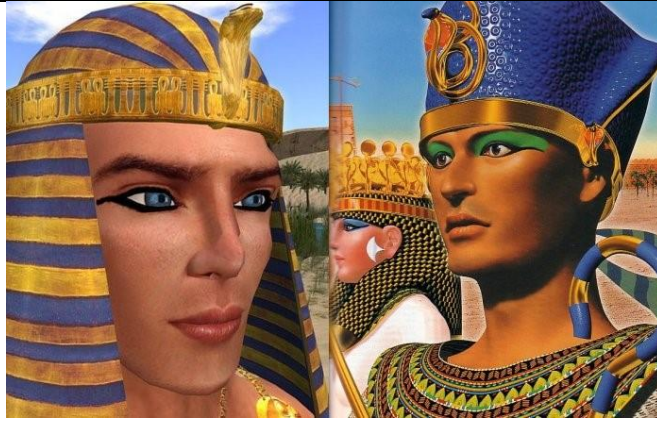
