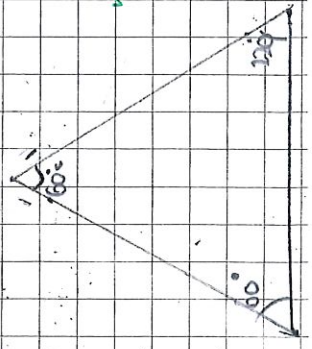
A square with sides that are 2 cm each



A rectangle with sides 2 cm and 4 cm each.

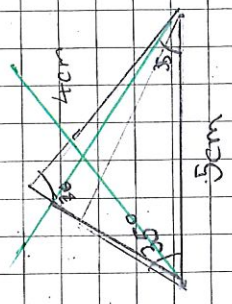
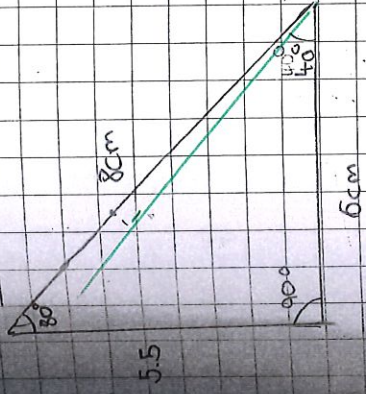

The Forth Bridge Edinburgh

It was opened in 1890, the Forth Bridge is a Scottish icon that is recognised the world over as the most famous of cantilever designs. In July 2015 UNESCO inscribed the Forth Bridge as the sixth World Heritage site in Scotland. A full-scale restoration project to return the bridge to its original construction condition was completed in 2012.

Holyrood Scottish Parliament in Edinburgh

Construction of the building commenced in June 1999 and the members of the Scottish Parliament held their first debate in the new building on the 7th September 2004. Within the UNESCO World Heritage site in central Edinburgh. The Scottish Parliament Building is the home of the parliament at Holyrood.

The parliament buildings at Stormont in Northern Ireland

The parliament building. The architect Sir Ronald Chisholm was knighted by King George V in recognition of his architectural work. He designed the building with perfect symmetry and style, such as a building being 365 ft wide.
