Leprechauns stepped on the enchanted island for anyone east island before any human did.

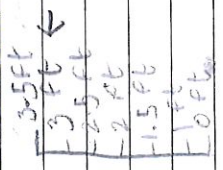
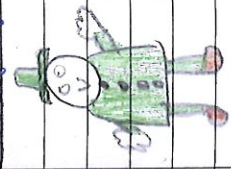

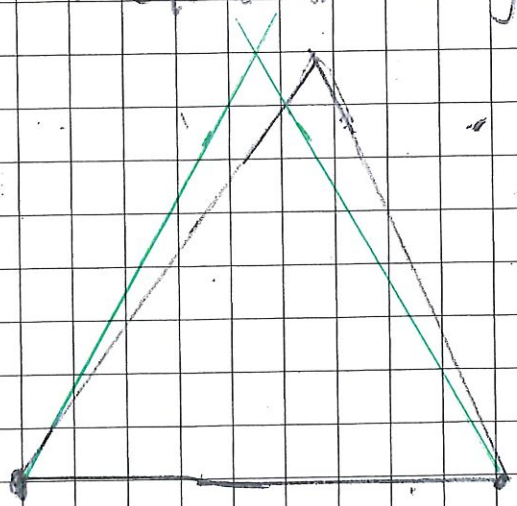
A square with sides that are 5cm each



A rectangle with sides that are 2cm and 4cm each



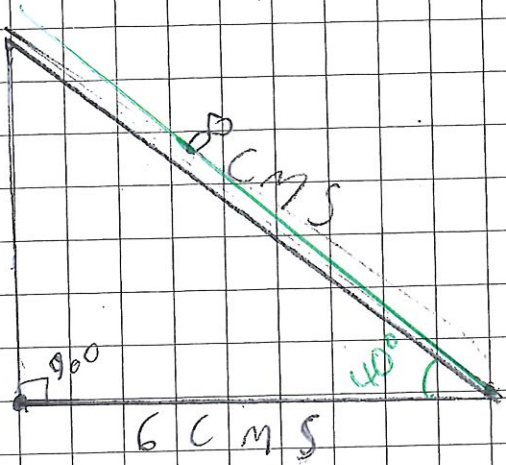
An equilateral triangle with sides that are 6cm

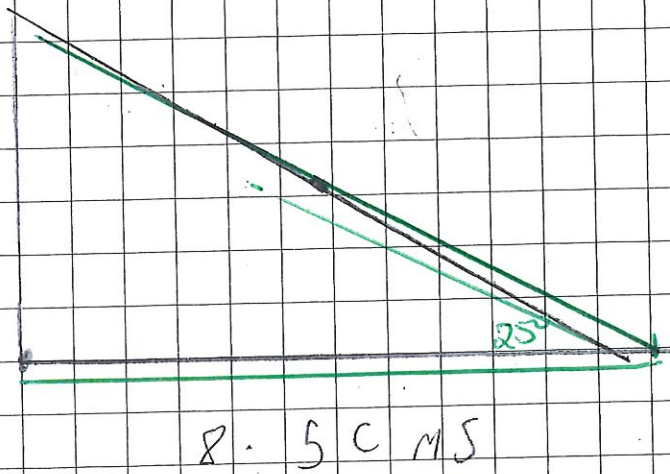

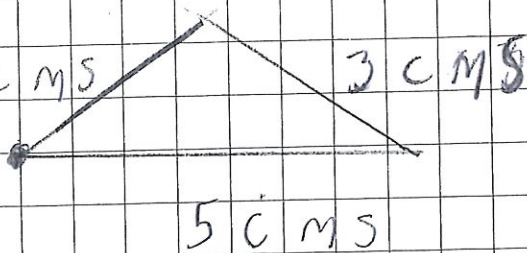
