



COVID-19 Catch Up Premium (Click link for more information) [coronavirus \(COVID-19\) catch-up premium](#).

In the year 20/21 St Mary's RC Primary School received £4060 to support pupils through the catch-up premium.

We have identified the following areas as priorities for our pupils:

- **Reading** – to support children to increase their fluency and reach their expected age related standard following time away from school.
- **Phonics & Grammar** – to support children to fill any gaps in their phonic/ grammatical ability due to missed learning during lockdowns.
- **Maths** – to provide tailored interventions to support pupils to reach their expected age related standard.

Therefore, our expenditure of this additional funding will be in the following areas:

- **Resources** – bought in intervention schemes for Monster Phonics Reading books (£640), Bounce Back Phonics (£60), Fast Forward Grammar (£60), White Rose Maths (£120), MyMaths (£426) **Total = £1306**
- **Consumable Resources** – text books, paper, pencils etc. **Total = £500**
- **Staffing** – All interventions to be led by Class Teacher – TA to be paid TA3 to look after remainder of class whilst small group interventions take place/ timetabled as one day per week. **Total = £2254**

We will measure the impact of the expenditure upon pupils' attainment in the following ways:

- **Formal in house assessments** (start and end of assessment) **charting attainment and progress**
- **Teacher Assessment of skills being applied in lessons not just in intervention sessions**
- **Professional evaluation of acquired resources.**
